Marignana Arte, in collaboration with the Accademia di Belle Arti di Venezia, promotes the project *Liberi tutti*. The initiative proposes to exhibit the works of eighteen young artists from the ateliers of the Academy with the aim of showing the most recent results of their research. The exhibition will be divided into three periods (from February 11th to March 4th, 2023; from March 11th to April 1st, 2023; from April 8th to April 29th, 2023), each one involving the participation of six different young artists - students and former students of the Accademia - with their own works. The beginning of the exhibition will coincide with Luca Massimo Barbero's presentation of the book *Illusioni*. *Il tempo è dalla mia parte (Illusions. Time is on my side*). The book focuses on the work of Aldo Grazzi, who had been teaching at the Accademia for years, to whom the title of the exhibition is intended as a tribute. The works in the volume also include the bead works exhibited by Marignana Arte in Grazzi's



solo exhibition entitled *Illusioni* (*Illusions*), which is still running and can be visited until February 18th, 2023.

The concept of art and the concept of freedom have always lived in an inseparable dialectic. On the one hand, the freedom of theoretical and practical experimentation has always been a necessary condition for making art; on the other hand, it would be impossible not to consider the drive for freedom that the enjoyment of the work of art itself has always generated. In this perspective, *Liberi tutti* is a project that does not intended to forcefully create a link among the works on display, but rather seeks to express a polysemic signification - also in homage to Grazzi's artistic and academic career - underlying different research conducted by young and promising artists. The exhibition is a reminder of the beauty of the freedom of artistic creation and fruition, divided into three chapters, where the works of the following artists will be presented:

Chapter 1 – from February 11th to March 4th, 2023: Alessandro Artini, Federico Borroni, Weichao Chen, Luca Marignoni, Chiara Peruch, Paolo Pretolani.

Chapter 2 - from March 11th to April 1st, 2023: Silvia Luisa Elena Faresin, Megan Freeman, Silvia Giordani, Marco Mastropieri, Laura Omacini, Francesca Vacca.

Chapter 3 - from April 8th to April 29th, 2023: Alessandro Bevilacqua, Francesco Cima, Bruno Fantelli, Simone Rutigliano, Giordano Tricarico, Fabiano Vicentini.
